

Enhanced Existing Camp Sites

A total of 53 camping sites will be enhanced with power, potable water and sewer services.

EXISTING CAMPING FACILITIES

The scope of works includes the provision of a concept servicing strategy to provide electricity, potable water and sewer to each individual camp site as well as providing sufficient capacity for future growth (i.e. inclusion of additional camp sites).

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ADDITIONAL FEATURES:



Wifi Upgrade - Repeater station may be required or microwave link to enable customer use of park wifi.

CAMPING GROUND SURFACE

Astroturf is non-toxic, water saving and reduces carbon emissions by not having to use fuel burning machines to maintain the sites.

SEWER VERSUS SEPTIC SYSTEM

The existing Septic System at the Camp Ground is inefficient, aged and requires upgrade.

Connecting the Camp Ground amenities, facilities and sites to the town sewer will ensure a safer, cleaner tourist precinct.

EXISTING SITES TO BE SERVICED

The existing 53 sites do not have water, electricity or sewer/sullage.

This project will bring these services to each site resulting in safer, better sites.
